







This Month: HOWIE MANDEL

We asked the funny, fist-bumping host of Deal or No Deal to pick 21 briefcases containing silly questions — and before the banker could make him a better offer, he accepted ours!



HOWIE MANDEL: Why do people always wonder about that? It's simple! I know them all because I work with them every day and they always stand in the exact same spot. MK: You seem like you'd be a cool dad. What's the hardest thing about raising your three kids? HM: Remembering their names.


they can all control their farts. When they do their yoga moves and stretches it's not just their souls that are released.

you listen really closely, those three

in Muppet Babies.



MK: Is it true that you once grew a mustache on the side of your face instead of the standard underthe-nose location?

HM: Yes. I wanted a mustache but I didn't want to get food in it and I didn't want it to tickle my lip. So I grew it on the side of my face. I had a real mustache — it just wasn't where everyone else's is.

MK: Who does your hair? And how often do you shave your head?
